RoHS compliance

The RoHS Directive, (2011/65/EU and 2011/65/EC) together with the WEEE Directive (2002/96/EC), concerns manufacturers and importers of electronics and electrical equipment and is part of the general EU environmental policy.

The purpose of the RoHS Directive is to restrict the use of certain forbidden substances, such as:

- Lead
- Chromium and Chromium VI
- Cadmium
- Mercury
- Biphenyl poly-brominated (PBB)
- Ether diphenyl poly-brominated (PBDE)

The company DAFA has high standards for human health and environmental awareness and declares to comply with the requirements in RoHS.
